



**BEHIND ON RENT? QUALIFIED SNOHOMISH COUNTY HOUSEHOLDS MAY BE ABLE TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE**

**GET STARTED BY CALLING 2-1-1**

Specialists are available **Monday - Friday, 9am-4pm** to complete the eligibility screening. Households applying for rental assistance are advised to collect the following documents:

- Rental agreement
  - Verification of rent due
  - 2020 or 2021 Tax Form to verify annual income eligibility
- Other income proof within last 60 days (if not filing taxes)

**EVICTION RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

- Household income must be at or below 80% Area Median Income (see table)
- Assistance varies depending on household income level
- No pandemic financial hardship required
- Must have rental arrears, but the 14-Day Pay or Vacate notice not required
