POSITION DESCRIPTION:

- Acts as part of wrap-around support team for Disability Services' Supported Living client population.
- Assists in data collection and development of client Functional Assessments and Positive Behavior Support plans.
- Assists in the development of client IISP plans.
- Provides training and support for Direct Support Professionals in relation to client PBSP implementation and behavior tracking. Trainings may be provided both at client sites, as well as in an office setting.
- Works one-on-one with clients in their homes as needed.
- Provides guidance for ongoing behavioral supports, including locating additional behavioral/mental health resources as needed.
- Must maintain accurate record of services delivered, time worked, and mileage expenses incurred, document data to show individual progress toward goals on service plan, ensure that the Regional Director is informed of events impacting individuals receiving supports and services.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age, have a high school diploma and some college, BA in a related human service field preferred. Related experience can be substituted for educational requirements.
- Must have at least two years of experience providing care for individuals with developmental disabilities
- Required, as a condition of employment, to obtain an agency affiliated counselor credential and a CPR/first aid certification within 90 days of employment.
- Must be able to acquire Long Term Care Worker certifications within 120 of hire.
- Must have a reliable vehicle and be able to travel when required.
- Must have and maintain an acceptable background inquiry per State guidelines.
- Intermediate computer and Internet skills required.
