Home Delivery Driver for Volunteers of America Western Washington Greenwood Food Bank:

Volunteers of America's Greenwood Food Bank operates a home delivery program that delivers food to over 50 seniors and disabled adults in the north Seattle area. Without this program, these individuals would struggle to access the food bank. **Drivers use their own vehicles and have some flexibility with pick ups. Deliveries are made on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday/Thursday of the month between 1:00 - 5:00 PM.**

General functions: "Adopt-a-neighbor" and make monthly or bi-monthly deliveries to a minimum of 3 households. Pick up food bags/boxes from the food bank and deliver to hungry neighbors. **This is a great opportunity for individuals or a team of two! If you want to make a big impact but don't have a lot of time, this opportunity is perfect for you - a couple hours a month means that our seniors will receive the food they need.**

Qualifications: Must be able to follow instructions and interact appropriately with various low-income and diverse populations in a non-discriminatory manner. Ability to bend and lift 50 pounds. Familiarity with Volunteers of America facts and mission statement.

Principle activities: Bend and lift 50 pounds, be flexible/adaptable to change, adhere to safety requirements, follow proper food handling and storage techniques, possess a friendly and positive attitude.

End results: Volunteer advocate for Volunteers of America's mission, support services provided are efficient and effective, hunger among low income families and individuals will be reduced, contributes to the successful operation of the home delivery program.
