POSITION DESCRIPTION:

- Primary responsibility is to answer online crisis chats that originate from the Lifeline chat portal and carecrisis.org
- Provide coaching, mentoring, and consultation to volunteer Chat Specialists and perform active rescue procedures as needed
- Perform a basic daily review of chat transcripts as defined by the Program Manager
- Maintain the volunteer schedule throughout each month
- Act as the primary trainer during the shadowing portion of volunteer training

QUALIFICATIONS:

- AA Degree in Human Services, Behavioral Science or a related field. Bachelors Degree preferred
- One (1) years experience in a mental health position
- Washington state credentialing required
- Crisis intervention experience strongly preferred
- Training in suicide prevention and intervention strongly preferred
- Excellent computer skills including the ability to type quickly with few errors and be comfortable utilizing technology to provide online support
- Strong writing skills with proven ability to communicate effectively through written communications and instant messaging
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Ability to work cooperatively as a clinical team member
- Demonstrated respect for diversity
- Flexible with respect to scheduling. Weekends, holidays, evenings shifts are required
