

Snohomish County is actively working to hire up to twenty-five temporary workers to support our ongoing COVID-19 response and recovery. Employment will begin in July and potentially last through December 31, 2020.

The following positions are being posted to the Snohomish County Website:

- *Temporary Shelter Manager* – This position is designed to primarily serve as a manager at the Snohomish County Isolation and Quarantine Facility. There is flexibility with this position. Depending on needs, they may also cover duties at our temporary shelter site. We will provide training for both of these roles.
- *Temporary Shelter Coordinator* – This position is also designed to serve as a coordinator at the Snohomish County Isolation and Quarantine Facility. There is flexibility with this position. Depending on needs, they may also cover duties at our temporary shelter site. We will provide training for both of these roles.
- *Temporary Emergency Management Worker* – This position is versatile and is designed to serve programs such as the Snohomish County Isolation and Quarantine Facility, temporary and cold weather shelters, Nourishing Neighborhoods, SAFE Teams. There are also a few of these roles that are available to serve as administrative support in the Snohomish County Emergency Management Emergency Coordination Center.

We are accepting applications now and will conduct interviews and hire within the next three weeks.
