This position is responsible for contributing to the smooth day-to-day operations of a busy warehouse as well as the occasional field trips to make deliveries or rescue groceries. Primary responsibilities include checking incoming and outgoing orders for accuracy, storing product safely, inventory control, loading and offloading trucks, general cleaning of the warehouse and equipment, and driving agency vehicles when needed.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Assist in loading and offloading trucks
- Prepare pallets for shipment
- Operate forklifts, pallet jacks and hand trucks
- Drive refrigerated box truck and/or other agency vehicles to pick-up food donations or make deliveries
- Participate in inventory counts
- Accept food and cash donations from donors
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor
